As part of the school's ongoing safeguarding reviews, we have updated our routines for the start and end of the school day, which will come into effect from Monday 1 November 2021

8.45am From this time, children should enter school via the driveway and the main gate. Parents/carers should continue to use the one-way system and exit via the pedestrian entrance.

Children should make their way straight to their class lines (in front of the small gates into the main school entrance) where a staff member will direct them into school to wash their hands and begin a quiet morning learning task before register. **All children will enter the school building via the main school entrance.**

It is a parent/carer's responsibility to ensure a member of staff is on the playground prior to leaving their child.

8.55am All children should be in school by 8.55am ready for registration at 9.00am. **If you drop your child off at school after 8.55am, please escort your child onto the school premises via the pedestrian gate; take your child to the main entrance and inform Mrs Ellison of your child's arrival so that they can be escorted to their classroom. Please ensure that you close/secure all gates behind you when you leave.**

9.00am Morning Registration

10.15am Whole School Assembly (most mornings)

10.30am Morning Break

12.15pm Lunch

1.15pm Afternoon Registration

3.15pm School Day Ends – the one-way system is still in operation. Children will leave via the main school entrance. Parents/carers can wait at the bottom of the playground at 3.15pm until a member of staff sees you and can safely handover your child(ren), but **please remember to be responsible and social distance whilst waiting for your child to help protect any vulnerable adults.**

Dear All,

We have reached the end of a half term that in my experience has been one of the hardest in memory; I know each and every member of staff has given their all and they all deserve a good break.

It has been great to get back to whole-school assemblies, playtimes and lunchtimes, and the children have adapted extremely well to the changed procedures again. But the term has been a little fraught also, as Covid-19 cases have appeared across school, in children and in some staff members.

Our staff have worked their hardest, as ever, to help ensure the safety of the children as well as to ensure that the highest quality education is offered to them at all times. I have once again been bowled over by their commitment and their enthusiasm for their work.

This term, the staff in Class 1 and 2 have made huge adjustments to the way they teach phonics and reading to the children, and this has increased their workload significantly. The end result of this hard work is that they all feel extremely confident using Rocket Phonics, and they can already see the benefits it brings to the younger children who are just embarking on their reading journey. I am very grateful to all the staff for their efforts and dedications, in particular to Mr Craven and Mrs Bateman. Mr Craven has led meetings in school to help parents understand how we teach phonics and how they can help their children at home, and he has another event planned for 2nd November which promises to be very beneficial to parents, see below. Mrs Bateman has invited parents in to watch her phonics lessons in order to model our approach in the hope that parents will feel more confident reading with your children at home.

All teachers have opened their doors this half term and invited parents in for curriculum evenings, and I am extremely grateful to them for staying late once again and offering you an insight into life in the classroom. Please remember, you are free to ask at any time if you'd like help with supporting your children's learning at home.

This week has seen an incredible experience for the children of Class 4 as they have spent the week at Humphrey Head on residential. I had the pleasure of spending 2 days and 1 night with the class and it was such good fun – the children were so keen to try things out and were not afraid to get wet. I returned exhausted as there really is no break when supervising a residential – it is a 24-hour a day responsibility as you have to be always alert to any incident. I think we owe a huge debt of thanks to Mrs Fawcett, Mrs Hill and to Jenny Smith for giving up an entire week of their lives to help ensure that Class 4 enjoyed an experience that will live long in their memories. Sometimes in schools, we just expect that staff will do these things, but it really is above and beyond, and I am so grateful to them.

I also extend my gratitude and thanks to all those parents who were involved in the planning and running of the Halloween Movie Night. This was another fabulous event which was enjoyed by all the children who were able to attend. The event raised a huge amount of money for school, which as I've mentioned before, in a small school makes a massive difference. The LSA are meeting on the evening of the first Monday of next half term and all parents are invited and would be welcome; if you have any spare time, or any great ideas for future events, please go along to the meeting in the school at 7pm.

Finally, a big thank you to all those parents who go out of your way to help us deliver a great experience to your children. Every minute spent reading with your child, practising times tables, talking about spellings and all the other things that we as parents do is time very well spent.

Class 1 & Class 2 **Rocket Phonics ~ Session 2** **Developing our knowledge of the alphabetic code** **and the skills of blending and segmenting**

Session 2 of our new **Rocket Phonics** programme will look at the alphabetic code and how we teach the two key skills of blending and segmenting.

For this reason, we would like to extend a warm welcome to all parents of children in Class 1 and 2 to this second training event in Class 2. Mr. Craven will guide you through the basics of phonics, introduce you to terms such as blending and segmenting, and give you tips on how to best support your young child when reading at home.

Your children can join Mrs Bateman's Magic Book Club for the time that you are in the meeting. Please keep babies and toddlers with you unless you can make alternative arrangements for them. The session will last no more than 45 minutes and will be extremely valuable to you, and most especially to your child, as it will help them make even greater progress in reading.




FAIR DONATIONS
