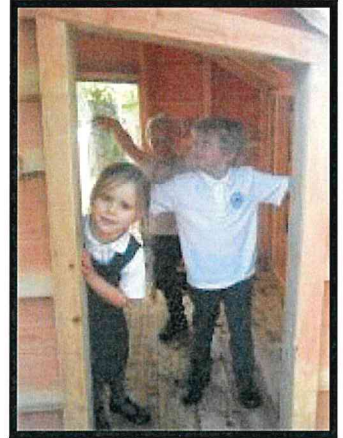
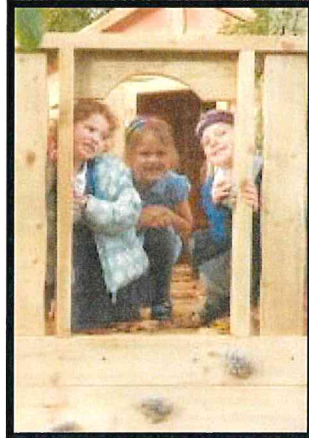
What's Happening in the Classroom and Beyond?

Whole School Storytelling Workshops ~ Thursday 18 October

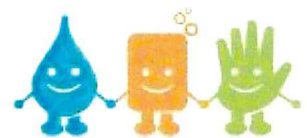





The Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal
