

Craven Cross Country Finals ~ Thursday 12 October 2023

Craven Cross Country Finals

Well done to our runners ~ Aravon, Hugo, Ruby, Sophie, Adam, Lucy H, Robyn and Tess — who represented the South Craven Cluster at the Craven Cross Country Finals at Giggleswick School on Thursday 12 October 2023.

This was the Craven round against all schools in the Craven district. We had a strong group of runners who had successfully made it through the first round at South Craven School. The course was both long and tiring, with some steep hills and muddy ground underfoot. All of our runners ran with a real determination and competitiveness to achieve their very best. And that they did. Every child produced a brilliant performance with lots of strong results.

All three of our Year 3 runners have now qualified for the North Yorkshire round in November. Hugo, Sophie and Ruby finished 1st, 3rd and 7th in their respective races. In Year 4, our sole participant, Aravon, put in a strong performance to come home in 10th place. Representing us in Year 5, over the extended course, was Lucy. A brilliant race with a close sprint finish to get over the line in another very impressive 10th place. We had three runners in Year 6; Adam, Robyn and Tess. In a very competitive Year 6 boys race, Adam represented Lothersdale excellently, finishing in 8th place with a very tight finish. The final race of the day was the Year 6 girls race. After a very fast start, it settled down with both Robyn and Tess in good positions. Both girls ran with grit and determination and did themselves and school proud.

LEGENDS 'Perfect Pets' Drawing Competition


