

There will be no clubs on the following dates: Monday 11 December 2023 due to the LSA Bingo Night.




Remembrance Service at Lothersdale Village War Memorial ~ Sunday 12 November 2023

Elections will be held on Thursday 9 November and the results announced in the Lothersdale Legends Assembly on Friday 10 November 2023. Thank you for your support.

Please remember that the deadline for the submission of application for a secondary school place in September 2024 is on <u>Tuesday 31 October 2023</u>. If you have not already completed the online application form, please do so as soon as possible.

Primary School Admissions ~ September 2024

Online applications can now be made via the Local Authority for reception places at Lothersdale Primary School for September 2024. The online common application form must be submitted by no later than <u>Monday 15 January 2024</u>. Letters from North Yorkshire County Council regarding applying for a school place have been issued this week to all those families who are on the school's pre-admissions list for September 2024. If you are the parent/carer of a child, or know of a child, who is eligible to start primary school next September and whose name is not on the school's register of interest, please contact the school as soon as possible.
