
Remembrance Day ~ Friday 11 November 2022

Please do not bring any prescribed or non-prescribed medicines into school on Monday unless you have completed an Administering Medicine form. Please note that medicines, including non-prescriptive medicines such as Calpol or travel sickness tablets, cannot be given to children unless a form has been completed. If your child suffers with travel sickness, please also remember to let us know if they have taken a tablet prior to arrival at school on Monday morning

If you think your child may need to take non-prescribed or prescribed medicine during the residential visit and staff have not been made aware, then please complete the Administering Medicine Form, which is available to download from school website via Info/School Office (scroll down to the bottom of the page). Completed forms and medicine must be brought into school on 14 November 2022 if you have not already done so and handed to Mrs Fawcett or the school office. Please do not pack any medicine in your child's bags. Medicines must NOT be handed to a member of staff on Monday morning without completing the appropriate form.

Please note that it is anticipated the children will return to school at approximately 2.30pm on Friday 18 November 2022. Please inform Mrs Ellison in the school office if your child will not be collected at 2.30pm so that we can safely account for all children at this time ~ we will need to know if your child will be picked up as normal at 3.15pm or will be going to Lothersdale Out of School Club.

If you have siblings in in Class 1 or Class 2 school, they can also go home with you at 2.30pm. Class 3 will be at their swimming lesson. If we do not hear otherwise, we will assume your child will be collected at 2.30pm and will ensure siblings are ready to go home too.
